Students who use the archive as part of a seminar or other course only require a weekly pass for the duration of a semester (October to February or March to June) after prior written registration by the lecturer.

2. PUBLICATIONS

When using reproductions of archival materials held in the Austrian State Archives for publication in books and e-books, illustrated books, exhibition catalogues, films, newspapers and magazines, calendars, on the World Wide Web and other new media, a fee of € 30.00 must be paid for each original used, a complete list of references has to be quoted and a free specimen copy – appropriate to the respective medium – must be sent to the address Österreichisches Staatsarchiv/ÖADS, Nottendorfer Gasse 2, 1030 Vienna or to the e-mail address oesta@oesta.gv.at.

For obtaining a university degree (Bachelor's thesis, Master's thesis, diploma thesis, dissertation, etc.) – if published within the required academic repositories – as well as for school graduation projects the use of archival materials is free of charge. For any further publication or for any publication other than this one, the mentioned fee has to be paid.

3. EXHIBITIONS

3.1 Stationary exhibitions

Use of originals				
A loan agreement must always be concluded with the State Archives for the loan of originals for exhibition purposes. The costs incurred (object framing, courier accompaniment, security recording, insurance, etc.) will only be calculated precisely upon conclusion of the loan agreement. The processing costs include administration, documentation, security images and restoration.

c) Taking your own digital photos and scans in the research rooms

Taking your own digital photos (smartphone photos etc.) in the reading rooms is generally permitted until further notice and free of charge, provided that other users are not disturbed. The use of a flashlight is prohibited. The use of one's own book and document scanners (only portable incident light scanners) is permitted. This does not apply to documents in oversize format and documents that are otherwise subject to a copying ban.

If, when responding to inquiries, the direct transmission of a small number of working scans (max. 200 dpi) by the archive departments of the OeStA proves to be expedient and thus administratively efficient, this may be carried out without charging the standard fees pursuant to Item 5. The assessment of proportionality shall be at the discretion of the respective heads of the archival groups (Bestandsgruppenleiter)."
